CLARENCE HISTORY MUSEUM NEWS

As of October 23, 2019, all our genealogy resources have been moved into the Clarence History Museum! The Trustees made the decision to locate all of the society resources in one building. This move facilitates more consistent hours for the museum. Wednesdays now begin at 9:30 for Genealogy Research and the museum begins open hours at 10:00am. The building now remains open until 3:00 pm every Wednesday. Our Sunday hours are the 2nd and 4th Sundays of each month from 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm. Tours are always available by appointment.

With our new hours, the Trustees have also decided the museum will be open year round! Only inclement weather should effect open hours. Exhibits will be changed while the museum is open as well as on closed times.
